## **TECHNICAL INFORMATION**

### Competition Venue

The competitions will be held in the Palau Velódromo Lluís Puig (Appendix B). Renovations, including a brand new hydraulic Mondo track, will be done.

*Note: A City and Venues' Plan can be found in Appendix C.*

### Warm-up Area

The Warm-up Area will be located 100m away from the competition venue in the Fair Building-Events Centre, La Feria (pavilion n° 5).

### Training Venues

Three (3) possibilities are offered: Outdoor stadium (with weight-training facilities), Warm-up Area (only Track Events, High Jump and Shot Put), Velodrome (only on Thursday)

### Facilities Site Visit

It is scheduled for Thursday, 6 March at 15:00

### Technical Meeting

It is scheduled for Thursday, 6 March at 16:00 at the Fair Building-Events Centre, La Feria. No more than two (2) representatives, and if necessary an interpreter from each delegation may attend. The LOC shall provide simultaneous translation in English and French.

### Training with Starters

It is scheduled for Thursday, 6 March between 17:00 and 18:30.

### Entry Standards

The Entry Standards have been approved by the IAAF Council approval during its meeting in Mombasa, Kenya on 25-27 March 2007 (Appendix D).

### List of Implements

It will be approved by the IAAF Council in August 2007 in Osaka, Japan.

Additional Shot Puts may be added to the approved list if requested by Member Federations or manufacturers (by latest 7 January 2008) and supplied to the LOC free-of-charge. All such implements must have IAAF Certification and be approved by the Technical Delegates.

Personal Shot Puts may be allowed, providing they have IAAF Certification and have been checked in accordance with the Technical Delegates' instructions. In addition, they must be available for use by other competitors.

### Timetable

The Timetable has been approved by the IAAF Council (Mombasa, Kenya, 25-27 March 2007) (Appendix E).

### Opening Ceremony

The LOC is considering organising the Opening Ceremony in the Palau Velódromo Lluís Puig on Friday, 7 March 2007.

## **ENTRIES**

### Conditions of Entries

- A maximum of two athletes from any one Member can compete in each individual event.
- One, two or three competitors can initially be entered per event, provided each has achieved the corresponding entry standard.
- Members who have no male and/or no female qualified athletes whom they wish to enter in any championships event may enter one unqualified male athlete and/or one unqualified female athlete in one event of the championships, with the exception of the Field Events and Combined Events.
- If the host country of the World Indoor Championships does not have an athlete qualified in an event, it may enter one athlete in these events (except the Combined Events) regardless of any entry standard.

### Relays

Each Member Federation may enter one team in each relay.

### Field Events

Member Federations may submit to the IAAF, by the time of the Preliminary Entry deadline (7 December 2007), the names of unqualified athletes whom they recommend to enter in the Field Events. The decision regarding the acceptance of such entries will be at the discretion of the Technical Delegates.

### Combined Events

For the combined events, eight (8) athletes will be invited by the IAAF in the Heptathlon and in the Pentathlon as follows:

- The top 4 athletes from the 2007 Outdoor Lists (as at 31 December 2007), limited to a maximum of one per country.
- The top 4 athletes from the 2008 Indoor Lists (as at February 18 2008).

In total no more than two male and two female athletes from any one Member Federation will be invited. Upon refusals or cancellations, the invitations shall be extended to the next ranked athletes in the same lists respecting the above conditions.

### Age categories

- Junior athletes (any athlete aged 18 or 19 years on 31 December in the year of the competition) may compete in any event.
- Youth athletes (any athlete aged 16 or 17 years on 31 December in the year of the competition) may compete in any event except, for the male athletes, the Shot Put.
- Athletes younger than 16 years (on 31 December in the year of the competition), CANNOT be entered in any event.

### Preliminary Entry

Member Federations must return the Preliminary Entry Forms (PEF) to the Organising Committee and the IAAF by midnight on Friday, 7 December 2007 (Monaco time) (Appendix F).

### Final Entry

- The deadline to submit the Final Entry Forms (FEF) is Monday, 25 February 2008 (midnight Monaco time). Entries must be submitted using the IAAF On-line Event Entry System: <http://evententry.iaaf.org>. The submission of Final Entries on-line for the competition will be possible from 25 January 2008. In case you cannot submit your FEF electronically, please contact the IAAF Competitions Division for assistance ([events@iaaf.org](mailto:events@iaaf.org)).
- The IAAF may request a copy of the official results of the event where the performances have been achieved.

### Final Confirmations

The deadline to receive Final Confirmations is 11:00 on Thursday, 6 March 2008. Such confirmations will have to be handed in at the CID for all days. The Teams must ensure that at least one Official is on site by that time. As in recent championships, Teams are encouraged to submit their Final Confirmations upon arrival at the Accreditation Centre.

### Respect of Entry Deadlines

- A USD 1,000 penalty per 10 participating athletes (with a tolerance of 2) will be imposed on any Member Federation which does not respect the Preliminary and/or Final Entry deadlines, (e.g. 3 – 10 athletes: USD 1,000 penalty or 11 – 20 athletes: USD 2,000 penalty).
- For more information, please refer to Circular M/28/04 dated 10 December 2004, page 6, item 6.4.

### Accuracy of Entries

- Penalties will be imposed on Member Federations which:
  - after having announced their participation in an IAAF competition, do not take part;
  - after having entered more than two athletes, attend the competition with a number 25% higher or lower than the number of entered athletes. The penalty will be USD 1,000 per athlete, after the first two athletes.
- The penalty will be debited to the account of the Member with the IAAF and eventually deducted from the Administration Grant the following year.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

Teams will be accommodated in six different hotels of a similar standard. Each will provide the athletes with working space, with Internet connections. Physio rooms and team meeting rooms will be also provided free-of-charge. The allocation of Teams in the hotels will be decided jointly by IAAF and LOC once the Final Entries are known.

**FINANCIAL SUPPORT**Quota

The Quota will be established by the IAAF Council during its November 2007 meeting in Monaco.

Preparation Grant

A preparation grant of USD 1,000 per athlete within the Quota will be paid to the Member Federations.

Travel

For athletes in the Quota, the LOC is offering economy-class airline tickets. These tickets will be issued preferably by the IAAF, provided Member Federations send their PEF and FEF by the respective deadlines. If a Member Federation prefers to issue the airline tickets, the cost of such tickets must be approved by the IAAF beforehand. Only approved travel costs will be reimbursed.

Travel costs of athletes outside the Quota and Officials will not be covered by the IAAF or the LOC.

Accommodation

For athletes in the Quota staying at an official hotel, the LOC will offer free accommodation in twin rooms for maximum five (5) nights during the official period (arrival Wednesday, 5 March – departure Monday, 10 March 2008).

The costs for teams are being finalised and will be made available on the LOC website.

The accommodation invoice will be based on the information (number of people, arrival and departure details) provided on the Final Entry Forms, with a tolerance of 2.

Reimbursement

Reimbursements will be made by bank transfer after the championships. Should a Member Federation exceptionally wish to be refunded in cash or by cheque on site, the President or the General Secretary of the Member Federation must send a written request to the before 25 February 2008, indicating the reasons for the request and the name of the person authorised to collect the reimbursement.

Any Athlete who surpasses the World Record during the IAAF World Indoor Championships will be awarded USD 50,000.

Athletes entitled to awards will be required to complete and sign a specific form, which will be made available at the TIC, agreeing to their participation in promotional activities for the IAAF and indicating the bank account details for the payment of prize money.

## UNIFORMS

All athletes must wear their Federation's approved uniform in competition. Please note that the IAAF Advertising Rules and Regulations applicable for these championships specify a maximum of 30cm<sup>2</sup> for the Manufacturer's logo size for the competition wear and 40cm<sup>2</sup> for sweatshirts, t-shirts and jackets.

There can be no logo of the Member Federations' national sponsors on the Athletes' clothes, bags, etc.

All team members must wear the same coloured uniform. Teams are requested to make the best efforts to compete in uniforms, the front and back of which, are the same colour.

All Teams must bring a colour photograph of their team uniform or a complete set of competition attire to the Accreditation Centre for inspection.

## IAAF AND COMPETITION LOGO

The use of all IAAF and Competition logos is possible only with the written permission from the IAAF. If you intend to use any of these logos for any purpose i.e. on any printed material, you must seek the IAAF's approval prior to their usage.

## DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the IAAF Procedural Guidelines for Doping Control/Anti-Doping Regulations. Additional doping tests for National and Area Records will be conducted upon request and at the cost of the relevant Member Federation or Area Association.

## INSURANCE

Member Federations are responsible for taking out insurance to cover illness or injury to members of their delegation and/or team when travelling to and from IAAF competitions and during the event itself.

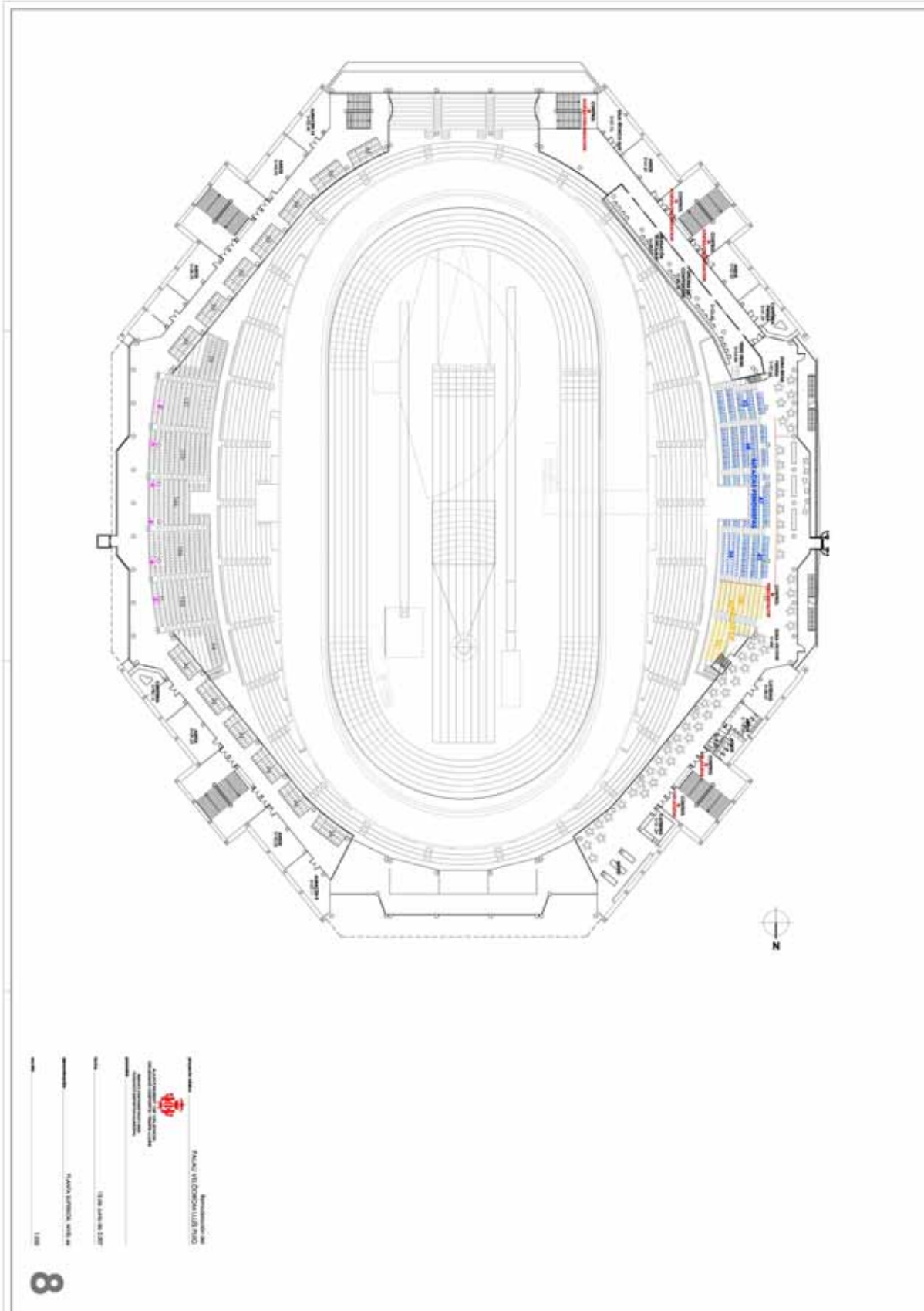

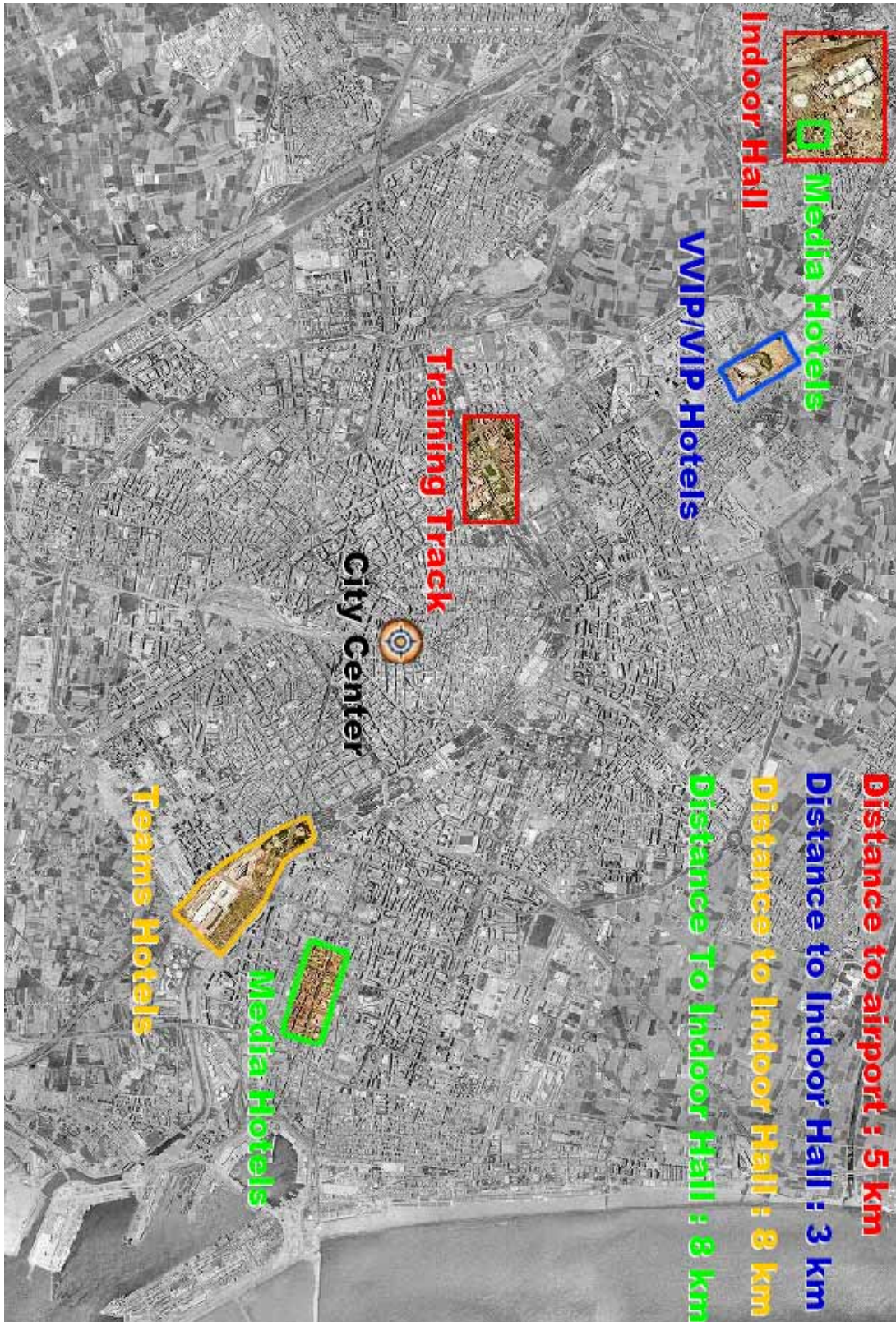

**ENTRY RULES:**

- Each Member is entitled to enter up to three competitors in each event of the Championships, provided all have achieved the corresponding entry standard, but only two will be permitted to compete (except the Combined Events and the Relays - see below).
- For the **combined events**, eight (8) athletes will be invited by the IAAF in the Heptathlon and in the Pentathlon as follows:
  - The top 4 athletes from the 2007 Outdoor Lists (as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007), **limited to a maximum of one per country**.
  - The top 4 athletes from the 2008 Indoor Lists (as at February 18<sup>th</sup> 2008).**In total no more than two male and two female athletes from any one Member Federation will be invited.** Upon refusals or cancellations, the invitations shall be extended to the next ranked athletes in the same lists respecting the above conditions.
- For the **Relays**, each Member Federation will be able to enter up to 6 athletes in each team.
- Members who have no male and/or no female qualified athletes whom they wish to enter in any event may enter one unqualified male athlete and/or one unqualified female athlete in one event except the Combined Events.
- The acceptance of unqualified entries in the Field Events is at the discretion of the Technical Delegates.
- **Youth athletes** (any athlete aged 16 or 17 years on 31 December in the year of the competition) CANNOT be entered in the **Men's Shot Put**.
- **Athletes younger than 16 years** (on 31 December in the year of the competition), CANNOT be entered in any event.

**CONDITIONS:**

- Performances must be achieved during the **qualification period** of 1 January 2007 to 25 February 2008 (midnight Monaco time), except for the Combined Events (see above).

- Performances must be achieved during **competitions organised or authorised by the IAAF**, its Area Associations or its National Member Federations. Thus, results achieved at university or school competitions must be certified by the National Federation of the country in which the competition was organised.
- Performances must be achieved during an official competition organised in **conformity with IAAF Rules**.
- Performances achieved in **mixed events** between male and female participants, held completely in the Stadium, will not be accepted (see IAAF Rule 147).
- **Wind-assisted performances** will not be accepted.
- **Hand-timed performances** in 60m, 100m, 400m, 60m Hurdles, and 100m/110m Hurdles will not be accepted.
- For the running events of 400m and over, performances achieved on **oversized tracks** will NOT be accepted.
